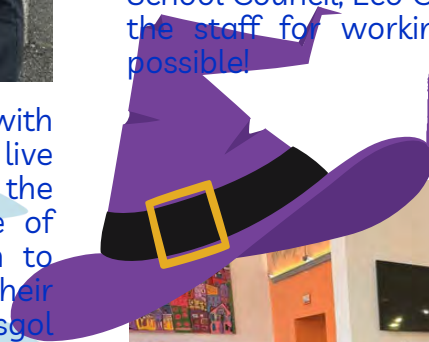

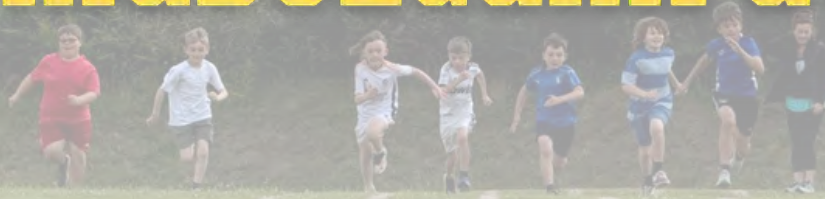


RALA RWDINS
